

RULES AND REGULATIONS
GOLDEN CLOAK AWARD

PURPOSE

To recognize and honor Majority Members of this Grand Guardian Council who have rendered outstanding service to the International Order of Job's Daughters.

REQUIREMENTS

(a) A recipient of The Degree of Royal Purple is not eligible for the Golden Cloak Award.

(b) The member must have a minimum of ten (10) years of outstanding service to the Order as an adult.

(c) The member must be nominated for the award by a bona-fide member (other than a relative) of this Grand Guardian Council using Form KS 21.

(d) The member making the nomination must secure four (4) written recommendations from Grand Guardian council members (other than relatives) representing four (4) different Bethels to be made on Form KS 22.

(e) Golden Cloak Award Nomination (Form KS 21) and recommendations (Form KS 22) shall be available upon request from the Grand Secretary.

(f) Completed nomination (Form KS 21) and recommendations (Form KS 22) shall be sent to the chairman of the Golden Cloak Award Committee prior to February 15 for consideration.

(g) The recipient shall be notified of his/her selection by the chairman of the Golden Cloak Award Committee on or before April 15. The recipient should not know of his/her nomination until this time.

(h) The recipient should attend an Annual Session of the Grand Guardian Council within three (3) years of her acceptance to receive the Golden Cloak Award. In the event that it is absolutely impossible for the recipient to attend an Annual Session of the Grand Guardian Council other arrangements for presentation of the award may be made by the Grand Guardian.

(i) The Grand Guardian Council shall be responsible for providing the recipient with a Golden Cloak Award Certificate (Form KS 23) and presenting a medallion bearing the recipient's name and date of the award engraved on the reverse side of the to the medallion. Expenses shall be paid from the Promotional Fund. .

(j) The ceremony for the presentation of this award shall be presented by the Grand Officers of the Grand Guardian Council during the Formal Opening of the Annual Session and shall be the ceremony approved by the Grand Guardian Council.
