RULES AND REGULATIONS  
SILVER LINING AWARD

PURPOSE

To recognize and honor adults who are not Majority Members of the Order, who have rendered outstanding service to the International Order of Job's Daughters.

REQUIREMENTS

(a) Nomination must be made by one or more members of the Bethel using Form KS 24.

(b) Nomination must be submitted to the line officer of that Bethel who will each in turn read it and individually make a recommendation to the Executive Bethel Guardian Council using Form KS 25.

(c) The Executive Bethel Guardian Council shall review the nomination and recommendations of the line officers and impartially vote for (or against) final approval.

(d) Nominee shall have a minimum of five (5) consecutive years of outstanding service to the Bethel as an adult.

(e) Nominee shall not be made aware of the nomination until after the final approval by the Executive Bethel Guardian Council

(f) Nominee shall attend a stated meeting of the Bethel to receive the award.

(g) The ceremony used shall be only that one approved by the Grand Guardian Council.

(h) The recognition ceremony shall be presented by the Bethel Officers as soon as possible after the award is approved.

(i) Silver Lining Award Certificates (Form KS 26) and plaques shall be available through the Grand Secretary.

(j) There shall be a fee amounting to the cost of the certificate and the plaque which must be paid by the Bethel.

(k) The Bethel shall be responsible for having the name of the recipient engraved in the space provided on the plaque.
