

Kansas Grand Bethel Beau 2012 Competition Information

To be eligible for Kansas State Bethel Beau:

- 1) Is not currently the State Master Councilor of DeMolay.
- 2) Has attended at least one Job's Daughters event in the past year (this includes a Job's Daughters installation, Grand Session, Grand Bethel, or State Reception).
- 3) Be recommended by a Job's Daughter.
- 4) Be no more than the age of 18 by the date of the competition.

Competition will consist of the following and be a total of all 4 categories:

- 1) An interview with the Judges.
- 2) Written test based on Job's Daughters.
- 3) Stage introduction.
- 4) Vote by all the girls present at the selection event.

Requirements:

- 1) Appropriate behavior and discipline must be maintained at times.
- 2) Job's Daughters chaperone Certified Adult Volunteer (CAV) rules **MUST** be followed at all times. These rules can be found at www.iojd.org.
- 3) The Grand Bethel Beau must always be chaperoned by an adult chaperone or adult family member when attending Job's Daughters functions.
- 4) An adult serving as a Job's Daughters chaperone may not serve as the Beau chaperone at the same event.
- 5) When attending overnight events the Grand Bethel Beau chaperone must be a parent or an adult male chaperone.
- 6) The Grand Bethel Beau will not enter the sleeping room or dressing room of any Job's Daughter.
- 7) All expenses incurred will be paid by the Grand Bethel Beau or his family. The Grand Bethel of Kansas will NOT be responsible for any of the expenses incurred by the Beau, his family or his chaperone.

Responsibilities:

- 1) Serve as the official escort of the Grand Bethel Honored Queen or other Grand Bethel Officer when in attendance and asked to do so.
- 2) Attend Job's Daughters functions around the state.
- 3) Socialize with **ALL** girls at functions where he is in attendance.
- 4) Promote Job's Daughter throughout Kansas whenever possible.
